

Rules and Regulations

1. Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated! There will be a strong police presence on the day as well as Internal Security on the grounds. This is a family fun event!
2. The Weekend on Wheels is an **ALCOHOL FREE EVENT!** There is to be **NO** consumption of Alcohol on the grounds at any time.
3. All damages to the Grounds etc... Will be billed to the person responsible. There will be **NO BURN OUTS** allowed nor damage to the Grounds which will be housing the event. Vehicle entry to the field on the day will be allowed after completion of all paper work, under the guidance of Event Officials.
4. This event is open to all makes and models of Motorcycles, Trucks, Cars and Vans. Prizes will be given for the best selections of vehicles as set out on entry forms. The prize(s) must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred or transferred. There will be no cash alternatives. Time: 7am to 5pm. Gates to the Public will open from 8am.
5. All pre entries received by the Weekend on Wheels committee prior to 18th of May 2019 will go into the draw to win a Mega prize to the value of \$800.00
To qualify as a Pre Entrant, Entry Fees must be paid AT LEAST 7 DAYS Prior to the event!
Late Entries can be lodged at the gate from 7am up until 11am on the day.
6. Entry forms must be completed and given to event officials before gaining entry into the event. The organiser may refuse an entrant's entry or continuation in the competition if the organiser deems (at its sole discretion) that the entrant's behaviour is unacceptable, unsafe or inappropriate. Taree Volunteer Rescue Association Inc. does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries. No responsibility is accepted for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently.
All entrants MUST complete and sign a Weekend on Wheels entry form, each vehicle MUST have an individual Entry Form. **Entry forms can be downloaded at www.tareerescuesquad.com**
7. Vehicle display ENTRY FEES are a Donation of \$10.00 (please note entry is for ONE person and that Vehicle only). Additional tickets can be purchased for a \$3.00 Donation per person or a \$6.00 Donation per family.
8. Judging will be conducted on the day by three independent judges, who have no ties or affiliation with any Car Club. Judging will be completed by 2pm and trophies will be presented by 3.00pm. Best Show Vehicle will be judged by People's Choice. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
YOU MUST DISPLAY YOUR EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER WHILST AT THE EVENT
If you do not display your Event Registration Number, your vehicle **WILL NOT BE JUDGED.**
